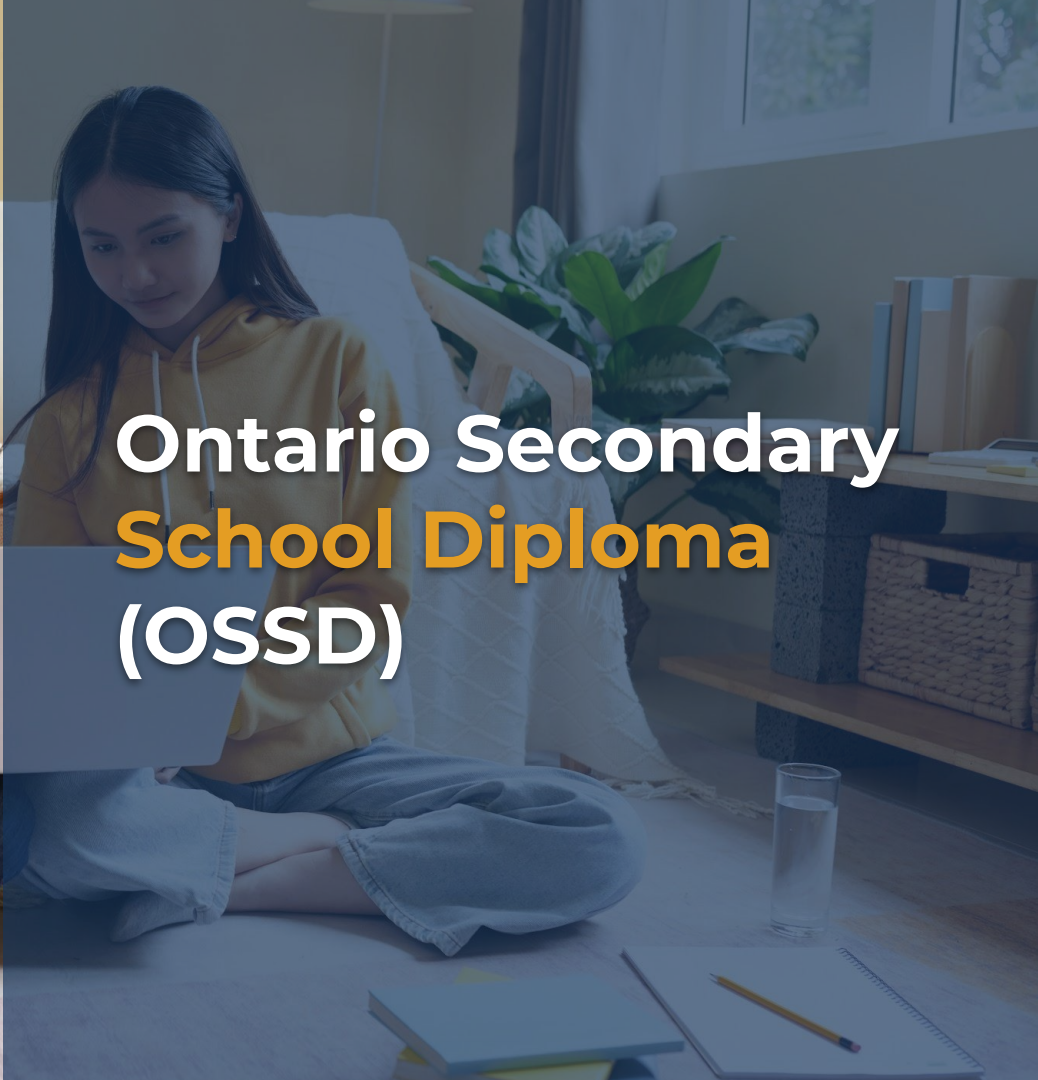

# Toronto Science Academy OSSD Program



## TSA OSSD Program

- **TSA Global Opportunity:**
  - Enables students worldwide to earn course credits and obtain the OSSD.
  - High school students can take TSA courses alongside their regular classes.
- **Dual Diploma Achievement:**
  - Allows students to earn both the OSSD and their local diploma simultaneously.
- **Well-Rounded Education:**
  - Completing TSA courses enhances credits and builds a globally and locally recognized education.
  - Meets both worldwide and local academic standards.
- **Flexible Learning:**
  - Program flexibility enables personalized learning for specific academic goals.
- **Preparation for Success:**
  - Sets students on a successful academic journey.
  - Grants a globally recognized qualification – the OSSD.



## OSSD Requirements

- OSSD Course Credit Requirement:
  - 30-course credit requirement, with each course completion earning one credit.
  - Minimum of 6 Ontario Curriculum courses.
  - Completion of the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test or Course is mandatory.
- Credit Equivalency Process:
  - Local high school coursework used for credit equivalency, counting each year towards 8 credits.
  - 3 years of high school contribute 24 credits.
  - Combined with 6 TSA courses to fulfill OSSD Course Credit Requirement.
- Community Service:
  - OSSD Guidelines mandate a minimum of 40 hours of community service volunteering.
  - Aims to instill community values by engaging students in positive contributions to their community.

# Admissions Step-By-Step





## Admissions Step-By-Step

- **Step 1:** Submit all required documentation, including a government-issued ID, proof of address, and academic records, following the Application Instructions.
- **Step 2:** Arrange a meeting with the TSA guidance counselor to discuss the next steps in the student applicant's educational journey.
- **Step 3:** The TSA guidance counselor identifies the student's strengths, interests, and academic history to determine course and program recommendations.
- **Step 4:** The TSA admissions committee conducts a comprehensive review, typically having enough information to determine to send an offer of admission.
